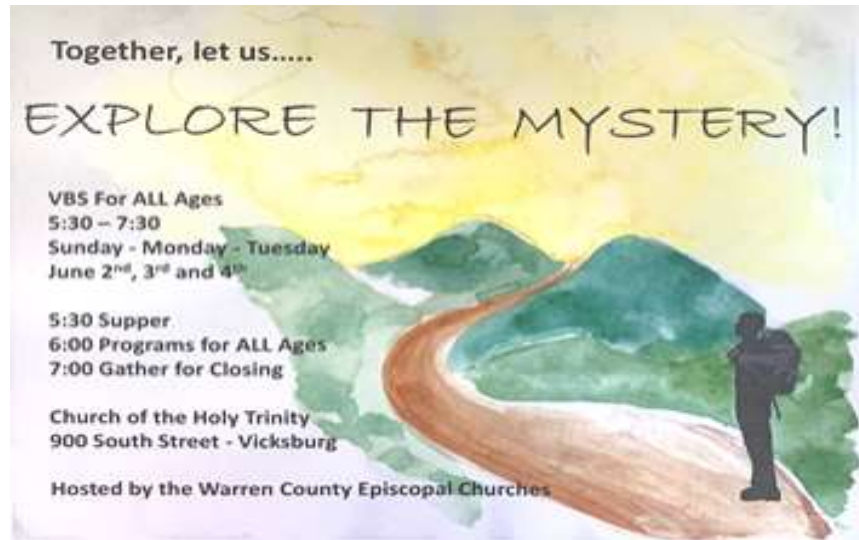




A message from Andy

Beginning August 4, we will offer two services of Holy Eucharist. **8 AM** will follow Rite One in the style of contemplative and meaningful worship in traditional language. This service will be held in the Chapel of Mary and Martha of Bethany. **10:15 AM** will be a Festive Eucharist of Scripture, prayers, rich musical offerings and the celebration of Holy Communion following Rite Two. **9:15 AM** will offer formation Sunday School for toddlers, elementary, Jr. High, High School as well as adult. This programming is scheduled for 50 minutes,
